

Policy for Placing Notices on the Commission Calendar:

- 1) All requests for placing notices of meetings or activity on the Commission Calendar will be considered on the basis of the following: program name, purpose of the announcement, date, and time, specific location (address, town and contact information), how long to place the announcement, and verification that the event is communication-barrier free or that a licensed or certified interpreter will be provided. If any information is missing, the request will not be considered.
- 2) Religious services will not be considered for the calendar. Instead, there will be a separate webpage for listing of church and temple services.
- 3) Any organization may ask to have their meeting or activity placed on the Commission calendar as long as the activity is open to the Deaf and Hard of Hearing people; communication is barrier free; and the activity is not promoting discriminatory, negative, or anti-social concepts.
- 4) The Commission reserves the right to accept or deny any request to place an activity on its calendar.
- 5) By accepting a request to place the activity on its calendar, the Commission and its staff do not claim any responsibility for the accuracy of details for that activity nor does it accept any ownership or responsibility for the philosophy or beliefs of that organization.
